### Abraham Lincoln

11. The final straw for the **South** was the election of Abraham Lincoln to President of the United States.

- 12. Abraham Lincoln was a member of the new **anti-slavery Republican Party**.
- 13. He managed to get **elected** without even being on the **ballot** in ten of the southern states.

#### **Secession**

- 14. When Lincoln was elected, many of the southern states decided they no longer wanted to be a part of the United States. Starting with South Carolina, eleven states would eventually leave the United States and form a new country called the Confederate States of America.
- 15. Lincoln said they did not have the right to leave the United States and sent in troops to stop the South from leaving. The Civil War had begun.
