Here are the landforms you should label.

- Your country is between two **oceans** on its **east** and **west** borders.
- In the **north** of your country is a huge **desert**.
- On the **west** of your country is a long coastal **plain**.
- Right in the **middle** of your country, but not touching any borders, is a **mountain** range.
- All **around** the mountain range is a large **valley**.

Early finishers:

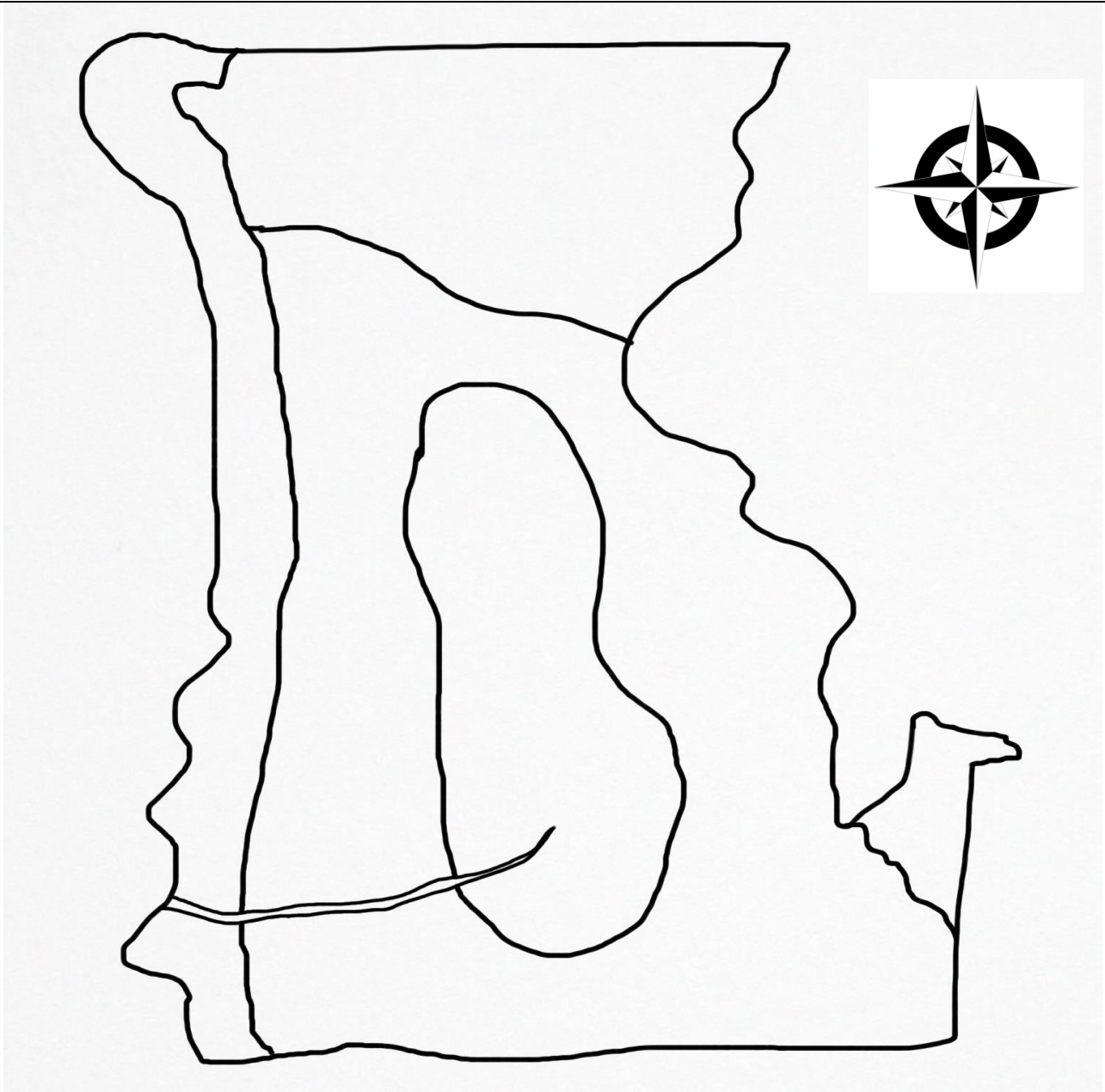
If you have time, label these landforms:
